SunFrame® contributes to Solar Decathlon winning entry by University of Colorado

ALBUQUERQUE, NEW MEXICO, October 15, 2005 — The University of Colorado again used a UniRac mounting product when it successfully defended its title at the U.S. Department of Energy's Solar Decathalon.

U.S. Energy Secretary Samuel Bodman announced Oct. 14 that the university had taken overall honors in the second Solar Decathlon on the National Mall. Its winning entry incorporated SunFrame, a UniRac system designed for superior aesthetics.

The university won the same honor at the first Decathlon in 2002. On that occasion, its entry used UniRac's versatile SolarMount system.
